Who We Are

Worship: We seek to offer Christ centered, Biblical music through a variety of musical style from classic to contemporary. We connect with local and national singers and songwriters who are passionate about our purpose and active in sharing the truth of Scripture.

Fellowship: We invite all people to come together for relationship building in a Christian atmosphere. We seek to build bridges in our communities, amongst our churches, and share the work of local ministries who endeavor to meet local needs in a Christ-like way. We partner with pastors, churches, and ministries to put forth quality events.

Family: We reach out to families no matter where they are in life. Whether it's camping at Worship on the Farm or celebrating Jesus' Birthday, generations can receive the message of the Gospel, worship together, learn from each other, and have fun!

What We Believe

The Bible: We believe the Bible to be the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God (2 Timothy 3:15- 17; 2 Peter 1:20-21; Matthew 5:18; John 16:12-13). We accept the sufficiency of scripture comprised of the 66 books of the Old and New Testaments. We believe the Bible is inerrant in the original writings with every part equally inspired (or God-breathed). We trust the Bible as our final authority in all matters of doctrine, faith, and conduct.

God: We believe in one God eternally existing in three distinct persons-Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who are one in being, in essence, and in glory, and each of these persons is fully God (Deuteronomy 6:4; 1 John 1:1; John 10:30; Acts 5:3-4). God is eternal (Psalm 90:2), infinite (1 Timothy 1: 17), sovereign (Psalm 93: 1) omniscient (Psalm 139:1-6), omnipresent (psalm 139:7-13), omnipotent (Revelation 19:6), and unchanging (Malachi 3:6). God is holy (Isaiah 6:3), just (Deuteronomy 32:4), and righteous (Exodus 9:27). God is love (1 John 4:8), gracious (Ephesians 2:8) merciful (1 Peter 1:3), and good (Romans 8:28). God is creator of heaven and earth of things visible and invisible (Gen 1:1; Colossians 1:16).

Jesus Christ: We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ. The eternal Son of God became man without ceasing to be God (Col 2:9, 1 John 1:1). The incarnate God was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of a Virgin. Being fully God and fully man, He lived a sinless life (Luke 1:26-33; Matthew 1:20- 23; Hebrews 4:15). We believe in his atoning death through His shed blood on the cross, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of the Father and His imminent return (1 Peter 1:18- 19; Philippians 2:8-11; 1 Corinthians 15:20; Mark 16:19; Acts 1:9-10,). We hold that His death, burial, and resurrection is sufficient to provide salvation for all who receive Him as Savior (John 1: 12; Acts 16:31). We believe Jesus Christ is our advocate interceding for us with God the Father guaranteeing eternal salvation (Romans 8:34-39; Hebrews 7:24-25).

The Holy Spirit: We believe in the deity and personality of the Holy Spirit. He is co-eternal with the Father and the Son (Acts 5:3-4). He regenerates sinners (Titus 3:5) and indwells believers (Romans 8:9). He is the agent by whom Christ baptizes all believers into His body (1 Corinthians 12:12-14). He is the seal by whom the Father guarantees the salvation of believers unto the day of redemption (Ephesians 1:13-14). He is the Divine Teacher who illumines believers' hearts and minds as they study the Word of God (1 Corinthians 2:9-12).

Sin and Salvation: Through Adam's sin, all humanity has inherited a sinful nature, and every person chooses to sin (Romans 3:23, 5:12), All sin is offensive to God (Romans 6:23). Man is utterly unable to remedy this fallen state (Ephesians 2: 1-5, 12). Jesus Christ came to save man from sin (Luke 19:10; 1 Timothy 1:15). Salvation is a gift of God's grace through faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross (Ephesians 2:8-9; Col 2:9-14). Christ's death fully accomplished justification through faith and redemption from sin. Christ died in our place (Romans 5:8-9) and bore our sins in His own body (1 Peter 2:24). We believe that Jesus Christ is the only means to salvation (John 3:16-18, 14:6).

The Church: We believe that the Church is a spiritual organism made up of all believers who are baptized by the Holy Spirit into one body (1 Corinthians 12:12-14). Christ is the head of the Church, the body of Christ, and all believers are united together in spirit and purpose to glorify God (Ephesians 1:22- 23, 5:23; John 17:21-23). We believe the local Church is central to God's universal plan for proclaiming and teaching the Word, encouraging and admonishing the saints, in addition to fulfilling the Great Commission (1 Corinthians 1:2; Colossians 1:24-29, 3:16; Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 8:1-7).
